2. By a cheque made out in pounds sterling drawn on an English bank in the U.K. payable to the Devon School of English Ltd.

3. By Credit cards - Visa, Mastercard, Eurocard, Delta, Switch, JTB, Access and American Express. The deposit of £100.00 should be paid over the telephone. We must ask for a surcharge of 1.95% on fees paid by Visa, Mastercard, Eurocard, Delta & Switch, 2.2% on JTB cards and 3.35% on America Express. In the case of late booking, remember that money can be transferred by banks in a few hours. (Swift Code= BARCGB 22)

Enrolment Regulations

1. This contract is subject to English Law.
2. Before students can be accepted on a course or reserved a place in a family, they must pay a deposit of £100.00 (which includes the Enrolment Fee), which will be deducted from the final invoice.
3. Before students can be admitted to any class in the School all fees must have been paid one month prior to arrival in England.
4. Fees, once paid, are not refundable in part or wholly. Students who are obliged to leave the school for personal reasons may arrange to transfer the balance of their fees (after deduction of tuition and accommodation fees already received) to another similar course starting at a later date, subject to the discretion of the Principal.
5. Students are not insured by the School or by the host family against illness, accident, theft or any loss of personal effects. The School cannot accept responsibility for any accident occurring during the course, on excursions or during group activities. It is, therefore, advisable that the student takes out an insurance policy in their own country to cover these risks.

Cancellation

Cancellation before arrival must be made writing, either by fax or express registered letter. The deposit is not refundable. The balance of the fees will be returned only if written cancellation is received four weeks before the beginning of the course.

Insurance

It is strongly recommended that the student takes out insurance in their own country to cover possible cancellation for any reason whatsoever.
